In order to be accepted, you must meet the above requirements and have at least one of the following: GPA of 2.5 or upper half of class rank, ACT composite score of 22 or 1,540 combined Verbal & Math on SAT. MSU Northern and Western Montana College require 20 on ACT and 960 on SAT. Students with 22 ACT/520 SAT Math score will be admitted as a full-time regular student. Students with an 18-21 ACT/440-510 SAT will be provisionally admitted.

SCHEDULING PRACTICE WORKSHEET

All senior students must have six (6) requests. Five (5) of these must be full credit bearing courses. Drill Team, Color Guard, Aides and Audited classes **DO NOT** count as credit bearing courses. Each student must select a minimum of 3 Alternate classes. A senior with a 3.2 GPA (**cum or current from the preceding semester report card or end of present semester**) may have an additional open.
