In order to be accepted, you must meet the above requirements and have at least one of the following: GPA of 2.5 or upper half of class rank, ACT composite score of 22 or 1,540 combined Verbal & Math on SAT. MSU Northern requires 20 on ACT and 1440 on SAT. Students with 22 ACT/520 SAT Math and an 18 ACT/440SAT English score will be admitted as a full-time regular student.
