**\*In addition, the Montana University System has certain requirements that must be met in order to be accepted by one of the colleges in that system. They are:**

World Language	2 credits (or 2 substitute credits in Career Technical or Fine Arts)

In order to be accepted, you must meet the above requirements and have at least one of the following: GPA of 2.5 or upper half of class rank, ACT composite score of 22 or 1,540 combined Verbal & Math on SAT. MSU Northern and Western Montana College require 20 on ACT and 960 on SAT. Students with 22 ACT/520 SAT Math score will be admitted as a full-time regular student. Students with an 18-21 ACT/440-510 SAT will be provisionally admitted.

### SCHEDULING PRACTICE WORKSHEET

All freshman students must have seven (7) requests. Five (5) of these must be full credit bearing courses. Drill Team, Color Guard, Aides and Audited classes **DO NOT** count as credit bearing courses. Please choose enough classes for the whole school year.
