



PHYSICIAN'S RECOMMENDATION FOR ADMINISTERING PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION

We are aware that at times it may be necessary for a student to take prescription medications while at school. It is preferred, if at all possible, that medication be administered at home. In the event it is absolutely necessary that the student take medication during the school day, this form must be completed and signed by the physician prescribing the medication. The form must also be signed by the parent or guardian before the student can begin taking the medication at school.
