

STUDENT GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBILITIES AND STANDARDS AGREEMENT

You have been elected to a Student Government position for the _____ school year. With your election, comes the responsibility to represent your constituents in a responsible, respectable manner. Toward that end, Student Government has established the following responsibilities and standards as they pertain to participation in Student Government at C. M. Russell High School.

ATTENDANCE

- School Attendance: Regular school attendance is expected of all St. Government members. Members must be in good standing according to GFPS attendance policies outlined in the Student Handbook. Accordingly members who reach the red zone in one or more classes may be removed from his or her position for the remainder of the elected term.
- St. Government Meetings: Attendance is mandatory for all planned meetings. These include club activity days, monthly meetings--before, after, or during school. Meetings will be clearly designated prior to the meeting date. Absences will be excused only when the individual in charge of the meeting (advisor or class president) is notified in advance of the absence. Members are allowed one absence per semester, per term. Attendance will be distinguished by semester.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Family, and school are priorities above the duties of student government; however, each member is expected to take part, on a regular basis, in student government activities.
- Class officers will monitor the participation of Senators and Representatives.
- It is the responsibility of each member to be aware of the issues and events with which Student Government is involved such as meetings, activities, and fund raisers.
- It is the responsibility of each member to comply with attendance, ethics, and standards in addition to the Constitution of C. M. Russell High School.

STANDARDS

- **As of the last day of the current academic year through the end of the next academic year**, any Student Government member who receives any consequence for use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco in or out of school, will be removed from his or her position for the remainder of his or her term. Members who are involved in violent or disorderly conduct may be removed from their position upon review of the Principal.
- Student Government members must be passing at least five classes each semester to maintain eligibility for student government participation.
